BEING A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF GRANDE CACHE, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO PROVIDE AUTHORITY TO THE PERSON IN CHARGE OF THE AKASAKA RECREATION CENTRE TO HAVE CONTROL OVER PERSONS OR GROUPS BEING ADMITTED TO OR WHO MAY BE EXCLUDED FROM ENTERING THE RECREATION COMPLEX OR GROUNDS.

WHEREAS, the Council for the Town of Grande Cache being desirous of the need of control of the Recreation Centre and grounds as to programming and scheduling of events and providing its patrons with the right to enjoy peaceable, safe use of the facility during such schedule or non-scheduled events,

AND WHEREAS, the Council for the Town of Grande Cache being duly assembled and under the authority invested in it, does hereby enact:

THAT, Custodial and Supervisory Persons in charge of the Recreation Complex have authority to exercise control over the admittance to as well as conduct in the Recreation Centre and on its grounds as well as the authority to exclude admittance to individuals or groups of individuals as he/she may deem necessary to facilitate the safety of and/or peaceable enjoyment of its patrons and its use of the programs and facilities,

THAT, persons failing to conform to or comply with requests or the directives of the person in charge of the complex may be charged by the R.C.M. Police and the Provincial Judge may levy a fine upon conviction and in accordance with the General Penalty By-Law of the Town of Grande Cache.

THAT, this by-law rescinds By-Law No. 254 and shall become effective on the date of final reading thereof.
