Council Highlights
September 22, 2015

Delegations

The Fox Creek ATV Club presented a report on their organization before Council. They requested a community grant from Greenview. The Council assured them that their proposal would be reviewed as a part of their next budget process.

Bylaws

The following bylaws were given second and third readings:

Bylaw 15-750 to re-designate Lot 10 Block 3 Plan 1273HW from Hamlet Commercial (HC) District to Hamlet Residential (HR) District

Bylaw 14-754 to re-designate the proposed 2.02 hectare \pm (4.99 acre) area within SW 9-72-1-W6 from Agriculture (A) District to Industrial (I) District.

First reading was given to Bylaw 15-173 to re-designate 14.66 hectares \pm (36.23 acres) within N 1/2-32-63-20-W5 & SW-05-64-20-W5 from Crown Land (CL) District to Industrial (I) District. A public hearing for the same was scheduled on October 27, 2015 at 10:00 am.

Wapiti Gravel Aggregate Purchase

Greenview will purchase 100,000 tonnes of crushed aggregate from Wapiti in the amount of \$1,032,000.00.

Sale of Surplus Equipment

Greenview will take part in the October 5, 2015 Ritchie Brothers Auction in Grande Prairie, Alberta for the sale of surplus equipment.

Enhanced Policing Position

Alberta Justice and Solicitor General has advised that the RCMP "K" Division have put a hold on Enhanced Policing Agreements, impacting the request that Greenview made for a new enhanced policing position to work out of Valleyview. The province and RCMP will be reviewing this decision in September 2016. Council directed the Administration to reapply for an Enhanced Community Policing Position in September 2016 and explore RCMP overtime coverage. Administration was also tasked with preparing a report regarding the renewal of the existing contract with the County of Grande Prairie Community Peace Officer Services.

Land Survey for Dollar Lakes

Greenview will provide \$20,670.30 to the Alberta Conservation Association for the purpose of conducting a legal survey to establish a land lease on Dollar Lakes.

Grande Prairie Museum Agreement

Greenview's Administration will enter into an agreement to provide annual operating funds in the amount of \$15,000.00 to the Grande Prairie Museum.

Valleyview and District Chamber of Commerce – Small Business Awards

Council approved Silver Package sponsorship in the amount of \$500.00 to the Valleyview and District Chamber of Commerce for the 2015 Small Business Awards.

Annual Harvester's Ball – DeBolt and District Agricultural Society

Greenview will be the Main Event Sponsor by sponsoring an amount of \$2,000.00 to the DeBolt & District Agricultural Society for the Annual Harvester's Ball, to be held at the DeBolt & District Agricultural Centre on October 24, 2015.

Increase Weight on Forestry Trunk Road

The Council agreed to increase the winter haul rates to 75,000 kg for the entire length of the Forestry Truck Road during frozen road conditions, as determined by Greenview Administration.
