## Council Meeting Highlights

May 26, 2015

### Delegations

- Dan Hague with Investors Group provided a presentation to Council regarding the AAMDC Councillors Pension Plan.
- Troy Birtles with Accurate Assessment provided information to Council regarding how fair market property value is determined throughout Greenview.
- Darryl Smith presented information to Council regarding the Little Smoky River Watershed.
- Ken Lindverd and Erin Monroe provided a presentation to Council regarding the Golden Triangle Consortium.
- Phil Dirks of Hawkins EPP Dumont Chartered Accountants presented the 2014 Audited Financial Statements which will now be submitted to the Minister of Municipal Affairs.

### Schedule of Fees

The updated Schedule of Fees was adopted by Council and will be posted to our website. Agricultural changes include the addition of new equipment and ASB request in price changes. Development changes are related to charges that were not listed on the previous Schedule of Fees. Environmental connection fees have been updated to clarify this is a fee and not a deposit.

### Recreation

Additional funds will be allocated to the Valleyview Multiplex in the amount of \$4,183,350. The additional funds reflect a contingency and moving the walking track over the fieldhouse as requested by residents at the Open House on May 6, 2015. Access to the facility will be improved and the change allows for a larger track and greater programming options. The Town of Valleyview will be contributing an additional \$856,830 to the project.

Council approved \$120,000 in grant funding to the DeBolt & District Agricultural Society for the replacement of the curling rink ice plant.

### Valleyview RCMP Enhanced Policing Position

Greenview will enter into an agreement with Alberta Justice and Solicitor General for an enhanced RCMP Community Police Position, working out of the Valleyview Detachment; \$80,000 will be transferred to the Protective Services Budget to fund this position for the remainder of 2015.

### Restricted Reserve Fund

Council approved the reallocation of part of the 2014 Unrestricted Surplus Funds to Greenview's Restricted Reserves. Reserve funds are created to fund future municipal projects as detailed in our long term operating and capital plans.

- Equipment and Vehicle Reserves \$1,250,000;
- Disaster Reserve \$2,000,000;
- Wastewater Reserve \$6,000,000;
- Operating Contingency Reserve \$3,500,000;
- Recreation Reserve \$13,600,000; and
- Bridge Replacement \$2,000,000.
