Council Meeting Highlights

June 14, 2016

Iosegun Lake Road

Council accepted a recommendation that the Iosegun Lake Road base paving project be awarded to Knelsen Sand and Gravel Ltd. Greenview will provide a onetime lump sum payment to the Town of Fox Creek, a partner in the project, in the amount of \$2,946,584.39. Funding for the work will come from Greenview's Road Infrastructure Reserves. Any unused project dollars, including contingency amounts, will be returned to the MD once the paving has been completed.

Sign Management Policy

Council discussed the management of signs within the MD. Administration has been asked to develop a Standalone Sign Management Strategy and Bylaw. This will be brought forward to Council at a later date for further review.

Letter of Support for Northern Gateway Pipeline Project

Council has directed Administration to send a letter of support to the National Energy Board advocating for the extension application submitted by Northern Gateway Inc. for the Northern Gateway Pipeline project.

Grande Cache Medical Clinic

Greenview Council has voted against making a funding decision regarding a proposed new Medical Centre in Grande Cache. Council determined that there was not enough information provided by the Town of Grande Cache to make an informed decision that is in the best interest of Greenview's taxpayers.

Teepee Creek Stampede

The Teepee Creek Stampede will celebrate its 100th Anniversary this year. During the June 14th Greenview Council meeting, Stampede representatives Dustin Hollingworth (President) and Mack Erno (Past-President), delivered an overview of the unique activities set to take place during the milestone event from July 14-17, 2016.

In recognition of the Stampede's Centennial, Greenview Council will make a monetary gift of up to \$25,000. A sponsorship request from the organization will also be considered by Greenview Council for Phase 2 construction of the Teepee Creek Ag Events Centre.

Cranberry Lake Rodeo Association Reallocation of Funds

The Cranberry Lake Rodeo Association was authorized to reallocate \$15,000 in unused 2016 grant funds to purchase a 50-horsepower tractor. The tractor will be used to help with grounds maintenance. The Association, through other grants and fundraising, was able to complete their capital projects without utilizing all of Greenview's grant funding allocation.

Capstan Hauling Rat 200 Jet River Race Sponsorship

Following the success of the 2015 World Jet Boat Races held in Grande Prairie last year, Greenview Council will support the Grande Prairie River Rats Association's 2016 Capstan Hauling Rat 200 Jet River Race. Council approved \$5,000 to become the event's Title Race Sponsor. Funds for the sponsorship will be allocated from the MD's Community Service Miscellaneous Grant fund.

The three-day riverboat event will kick off with a Show and Shine at Centre 2000, in Grande Prairie, on June 17th.
