Council Meeting Highlights  
October 11, 2016

### **Delegations**

Fox Creek RCMP Sergeant Warren Wright provided a presentation to Council requesting the M.D. of Greenview provide funding for an enhanced policing position within the Town of Fox Creek. The detachment currently has six staff members and is preparing for increased population due to industrial investment in the region. Council accepted the presentation for information and will consider the matter during budget discussions.

The Valleyview Municipal Library Board presented their 2017 Operating Budget to Council. The budget was accepted for information and will be considered in Greenview's 2017 budget deliberations. The Library Board also presented a request for repairs to the library's roof and foundation. The building's capital funding and repairs will be brought forward in discussion with the Town of Valleyview.

555 Design Studio provided a presentation regarding the Greenview Facilities Assessment Report. The report contained projections for Greenview's facility needs in the next ten years to meet operational requirements. Heated vehicle storage, cold storage, and office space were identified as priorities in the report.

### **Bylaws**

Bylaw 16-768 Road Ban Bylaw was voted down on second reading. The revised bylaw would have reduced the number of signatures required to implement road bans, allowing the CAO or his/her designate to approve road ban orders.

Bylaw 16-771 License of Occupation passed second and third reading. The bylaw will allow Greenview to hold agreements with future applicants for non-exclusive road allowance use. Commencing January 1, 2018 the road allowance licenses will be in effect for three year intervals and the program will be administered by Agricultural Services.


Bylaw 16-772 Local Authorities Pension Plan (LAPP) passed third reading. Part time employees who work between 14 and 29 hours per week will be offered optional enrollment in LAPP.

### **Road Construction**

Council rejected a road construction request from applicants who are non-residents of the M.D. of Greenview residing in Sturgeon Lake Cree Nation. The matter would have been precedent setting as Greenview enters into road agreements with its residents and doesn't have responsibility for building access roads for non-residents to reach Greenview's road network.

### **Technical Rescue and Dangerous Goods Service Agreement**

Greenview will enter into an agreement with the County of Grande Prairie to provide technical rescue and dangerous goods services within the municipality. Protective Services will initiate hazmat response service from the County of Grande Prairie Regional Fire Service if a biological, chemical or radioactive emergency incident occurs in Greenview.



## Donations

Council will donate \$800 to the South Peace Regional Archives with funds to come from the Community Services Miscellaneous Grant.
