Contact us before you cross

Due to the substantial weight of brushing equipment, a crossing agreement is required before performing work on the right-of-way. Contact TransCanada to apply for an agreement.



Call/click before you brush

Brushing poses a significant risk to the integrity of the pipeline as it removes soil cover. Before brushing, contact your local One-Call Centre – it's a free service! TransCanada will send a representative to mark the location of the pipeline facilities and must be present to oversee the work.

Brushing

What is the prescribed area?

The prescribed area, formerly known as safety zone, extends 30 metres on either side of the pipeline centreline. Excavation using mechanical equipment or explosives within this zone requires approval. Contact your local One-Call Centre to request a locate and TransCanada will come to the site and mark the pipeline.

The existence of the prescribed area does not mean development of the land cannot occur within the prescribed area.
