Introduction

Background

Big Lakes County and the Municipal District of Greenview have initiated a project to develop an Intermunicipal Development Plan (IDP) between the two municipalities.

This project is driven in part by new legislation within the Municipal Government Act that requires IDPs to be developed between all neighbouring municipalities.

The planning process for this IDP provides an opportunity for collaboration on matters important to both the County and the M.D, including service provision, land use, environmental protection, and future development patterns.

Objectives of the IDP are:

- Comply with all IDP requirements identified by the Municipal Government Act;
- Engage with community members and stakeholders in all parts of the project;
- Identify options for service provision between the County and M.D.; and
- Identify future land uses for the IDP area and establish regulations for intermunicipal referrals.


What is an Intermunicipal Development Plan?

An IDP is a broad-based policy document that is created by neighbouring municipalities. The IDP will focus on a limited area along the County and M.D. border and will address growth and servicing issues in a way that will respect the interests of both municipalities. The proposed IDP boundary was selected by the joint IDP Committee and will be finalized through public engagement.

Most questions in this survey are related to the intermunicipal fringe area shown in the map on the following page.

Project Timeline

It is anticipated that the IDP preparation, public engagement, and adoption of the plan will be complete by May 31, 2019
