Reeve Dale Smith's background includes hands on experience in the agriculture industry and a 35 year career in provincial public service as Range Agrolgist for Alberta Sustainable Resources. Since retiring from the province in 2013, he has continued to manage a family beef ranching operation in the New Fish Creek area with his wife Judy. Reeve Smith has been a Councillor with Greenview since 2013 when he was first elected.
