In accordance with Section 631 of the Municipal Government Act, an Intermunicipal Development Plan (IDP) is required between two or more municipalities that share a common boundary to identify the following:

- consultation, coordination and cooperation regarding planning matters of joint interest within a defined planning area;
- a framework for addressing land use concerns with regard to joint planning matters;
- a procedure for dealing with development proposals within a defined planning area; and
- any other matters relating to development considered necessary within a joint planning area.

Big Lakes County and Municipal District of Greenview No. 16 Intermunicipal Development Plan (Draft) identifies a specific area in Sunset House/Snipe Lake whereby the two municipalities are required to circulate land use amendment, development and subdivision applications to one another for comment.

Anyone wishing to speak on the above is invited to attend. Written submission must be received by Greenview on or before 12:00 p.m. (noon) on June 21, 2019.
