

RECYCLING AT THE GRANDE CACHE LANDFILL EFFECTIVE JUNE 29, 2020



NOTICE EFFECTIVE JUNE 29, 2020

The commingled recycling bins presently at the ball diamonds will be moved to the Grande Cache Landfill on June 29, 2020 where there will be separate bins for all recycling.

REDUCE RECYCLING CONTAMINATION

CONTAMINATED RECYCLING ENDS UP IN THE LANDFILL INSTEAD OF BEING RECYCLED.

When a bin of recycling is contaminated, the whole bin of recycling is considered unusable and is thrown away into landfills. Therefore, contamination can undermine the good recycling habits of others and cause recyclable items to end up in landfills. Our goal is for our recycling to end up at Edson Recycling Centre and not in the Grande Cache Landfill. The best way to ensure this is to avoid contamination by following the below steps:

1. Rinse your jars, glasses and recyclable food containers. No food allowed.
2. Know what items your recycling area accepts and does not accept.
3. Keep plastic bags out of the recycling bins.
4. Always look for a recycling label and match it to the proper recycle bin at the Landfill.

PLEASE SORT RECYCLABLES INTO THE BELOW FIVE (5) CATEGORIES:

1



Paper and magazines

Includes office paper, low grade paper and newspapers, flyers, comics, magazines, catalogues, boxboard (for example cereal boxes, no liners)

2



Tin Cans

All tin, steel or aluminum cans. Rinse, remove labels and flatten. Tin foil is acceptable.

3



Clear Glass

Clear glass jars and clear window pane glass. Rinse jars. Remove labels and lids. **No** auto glass, colored glass, ceramics, china or fluorescent light bulbs.

4



Plastic Containers

Plastic Types #2 to #7
Rinse plastic containers and bottles.

5



Cardboard

Flatten boxes.
