COVID-19 AQUATIC RULES

- All swimmers must pre-book their time slot. A maximum of thirty-seven (37) spots are available per time slot.
- Masks are not permitted to be worn in the water by swimmers, as they present a safety risk. Swimmers may wear masks on deck and in other areas of the facility.
- One-way traffic measures are in place with signage
- There are twelve (12) available spots during some swims for lane swimmers see the aquatic schedule for more information.
- The diving board will be open during some swim times. Physical markers are placed on the floor to show where divers may line up see the aquatic schedule for more information
- There is limited locker use available in the change rooms, and swimmers are permitted to bring their items onto the pool deck.
- Change stalls are available, with some being closed to ensure proper social distancing.
- All showers in the change rooms are unavailable for use.
- All swimmers must take a cleansing shower on deck before entering the pools.
- Swimmers must follow directional signage when entering and exiting the pool area.
- The center of the pool deck between the leisure and lane pool is off-limits for public use.
- To ensure proper social distancing measures are followed, it is encouraged that only one family or cohort be in the wading pool.
- To ensure appropriate social distancing measures, it is encouraged that only one family or cohort be in the lazy river at a time.
- All hot spots are closed (hot tub and steam room).
- Lifejackets are available upon request. Swimmers may bring their lifejackets from home, providing they are clean and in safe working order.
- No equipment will be available for use during any swim. Swimmers may bring their equipment (fitness, toys, etc.) from home, providing they are clean.
- Swim diapers are available for purchase at Guest Services for a cost of \$3.00
- The aquatic viewing area is unavailable for use.
- All other facilities and aquatic area rules are to be followed.


LANE SWIM GUIDES

- Lane swim etiquette is expected.
- Lane swimmers will swim using the right side of the lane and follow the black lines on the floor and swim in a circle formation while maintaining social distancing of two (2) meters.
- A maximum of six (6) swimmers can share a lane.
- Twelve (12) available spots are available in the lane pool during lane swim. See schedule "Lane Pool Activity".
- Booking a lane guarantees you access to the entire pool area and guarantees your shared lane.
