

# Invasive Plants Management

#### How does Greenview control invasive plant species?

Greenview conducts annual/bi-annual weed inspections, recording any findings and assigning every report a file number.

Weed Inspectors contact the landowners who have invasive plants on their property, to discuss the control options that meets their needs for the situation at hand.

The Agriculture Services Department has a goal for the upcoming inspecting season of educating and informing landowners about the various invasive plant species that are prominent within Greenview boundaries, as well as various control methods acceptable under the *Weed Control Act* of Alberta.

### What does Greenview do about invasive plants and brush within the right-of-ways?

Greenview conducts roadside spraying on a two year rotation to keep the ditches free of invasive plants and brush to improve visibility and roadside maintenance.

Agriculture Services also offers a Fenceline Spraying Program, a Private Land Spraying Program (two acres or less) and a Spray Exemption Program (deadline end of April) for residents. To partake in any of these programs, please contact the Agriculture Services Department at **780-524-7621**.



### **Pest Control**

#### What is the wolf incentive program?

The Wolf Incentive program is a current program in which landowners / ratepayers can harvest adult wolves in developed areas and claim a \$300.00 wolf incentive.

#### Does Greenview assist with coyote predation?

The Agriculture Services Department offers various control methods and information on coyote predation.

#### What is the Wild Boar Incentive?

The Wild Boar Incentive program is offered by Greenview in partnership with Alberta Agriculture and Forestry where residents can harvest wild boars and claim a \$50.00 wild boar incentive.

#### Does Greenview assist with crop diseases and insects?

The Agriculture Services Department will inspect and monitor crops for various crop diseases and insect pests. We also provide information on various other horticultural pests and diseases as well.
