BOIL WATER ADVISORY LIFTED BY ALBERTA HEALTH SERVICES

What does this mean?

Effective immediately, you can resume using the water for all activities without boiling it.

After the boil water advisory ends, we encourage residents, before using the water to flush their water lines by doing the following:

- Turn on all taps and flush water lines for at least 5 minutes (10 minutes if you live in an apartment building) or until no sediment or colour is noticed.
- You may also notice the chlorine smell since we raised up the level for further protection, and it is still under applicable level by drinking water quality.
- Read instructions from the manufacturer for how to flush, clean, and sanitize containers that protect and store drinking water (called cisterns), water filters, and ice and water dispensers.
- Drain and refill hot water tanks that are set below 45° C.
- Run water softeners through a regeneration cycle (see the instructions from the manufacturer.)
