P

Expectation

The Town of Grande Cache retains the ownership of all 240-litre residential garbage bins. These bins are to be used in conjunction with the front load garbage truck complete with mechanical residential arm.

O

Policy Statement

With the purchase of the front load garbage truck, the Town of Grande Cache is implementing a mechanical method of collecting residential garbage in order to improve service to our residents and as a cost savings measure.

L

With the purchase of the front load garbage truck, a specific type of garbage bin is required. As a result, every resident in Grande Cache will be required to replace their existing garbage bins with bins that are supplied by the Town. The Town of Grande Cache will provide one (1) 240-litre residential garbage bin, at no cost, to each residence in Grande Cache. These bins are the property of the Town of Grande Cache and will remain at the residence to which they are assigned.

I

The Town of Grande Cache will ensure:

- a) the name of the Town is placed on each garbage bin;
- b) each garbage bin is assigned a serial number;
- c) a system is developed to assign bins to residences and track the location of the bins; and
- d) a system is developed for the distribution of the bins.

C

Administration will develop and present an educational program on the garbage collection process, including the proper placement of the bin for collection.

Y

In the event a garbage bin is damaged or removed from the residence, the resident assigned the bin will be responsible for covering the cost of repairing or replacing the bin. The cost of repairing or replacing the bin will be included on the Utility Bill for the residence.
