## REMINDERS:

- SET** your Recycle Cart curbside for pick-up every 2nd Monday by 7:00 am for Environmental 360 Solutions (E360S).
- ENSURE** wheels are touching curb.
- MUST HAVE** 6 feet of clearance on all sides of the car, such as parked cars, etc.
- REVIEW** acceptable materials included in curbside commingled recycling program on the back of the page.
- CLEAN** recyclables & ensure they are dry.
- ALL BLUE BAGS** must be placed on the bin. Overflow items will not be accepted.

### NOTICE:

Please be advised that Environmental 360 Solutions (E360S) has been contracted for residential recycling pick-up in Grande Cache.

Their pick-up route is different from our last contractor, so please be patient as pick-up times may vary throughout the community on recycling day. Your bin will continue to be picked up on the every second Monday. Please leave your bin curbside by 7:00 am. The Recycling Calendar dates have not changed. Please see the reverse page for the 2022 Grande Cache Recycling Calendar.

### REMINDERS:

Please be reminded to only place the following acceptable recycling items in blue bags:

- ✓ #1 & #2 plastics
- ✓ Tin cans
- ✓ Paper
- ✓ Cardboard
- ✓ No sorting required
- ✓ Ensure that items are clean & dry
- ✓ Blue bags must be in the recycling bin
- ✓ All items must be bagged
- ✗ NO glass or organic materials
- ✗ NO food stuck in containers



**ALL items must be in BLUE BAGS & in the BLUE BIN.**

## ACCEPTABLE RECYCLING ITEMS



### ACCEPTABLE: PLASTICS #1

Polyethylene terephthalate (PETE) is a clear or green, glossy, rigid container:

- ✓ Clear and green soda bottles
- ✓ Cooking oil bottles
- ✓ Peanut butter jars (recyclable if clean)
- ✓ Salad dressing bottles and other food and drink containers (recyclable if clean)



### ACCEPTABLE: PLASTICS #2

High density polyethylene (HDPE) is also a hard plastic but is visibly different from PETE, as it is not transparent. It is usually milky or solid colors & rigid containers.

- ✓ Milk jugs and yogurt or margarine tubs (recyclable if clean)
- ✓ Detergent bottles, shampoo bottles, and other containers (recyclable if clean)
- ✓ Some plastic bags

### ACCEPTABLE ITEMS INFO:



- ✓ Tin/Steel Food Cans  
Labels are not required to be removed
- ✓ All Beverage containers
- ✓ Plastics #1 & 2  
Molded, rigid plastic containers & tubs with lids grade 1 & 2 only. All must be rinsed (i.e. detergent bottles, yogurt containers, condiment containers, plastic medicine bottles, etc.)



- ✓ Office paper
- ✓ Newspaper
- ✓ Flyer's
- ✓ Mailed paper  
Envelopes, magazines, catalogues, corrugated cardboard, box-board (cereal boxes (no liners) & door to door shipped boxes)
