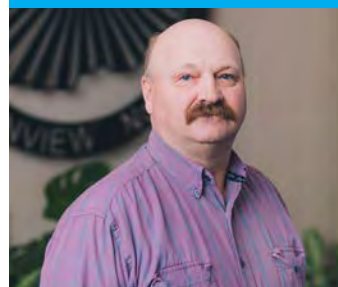

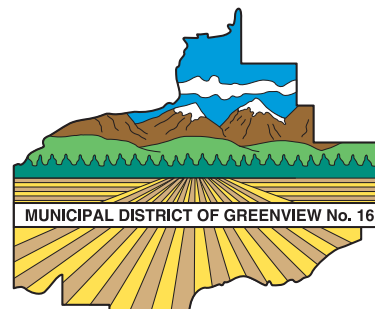

## Council Highlights Summary - Valleyview, Alberta

**June 16, 2022:**

### **Grande Cache Institution Pedestrian Pathway Project to Move Forward**

Greenview Administration has finalized an agreement with Correctional Services Canada representatives and will proceed with constructing a Grande Cache Institution Pedestrian Path in the 2022 construction season. The Grande Cache Pathway project is a project that is managed by Greenview but will be fully funded by Correctional Services Canada, an agency of the Federal Government. The project will consist of a 2m (6.5feet) asphalt walking path that will start from Berge Drive along Hoppe Avenue to the Correctional Centre.

### **Greenview Supports Blossoming Garden of Hope**

The Tiny Hands of Hope and the Compassionate Friends of Grande Prairie presented the Blossoming Garden of Hope to the Committee of the Whole on June 21, 2022. This is a one-of-a-kind Children's Memorial Garden in the Peace Country facilitated by the Tiny Hands of Hope and the Compassionate Friends of Grande Prairie in collaboration with the City of Grande Prairie and numerous other supporters.

The vision of the Blossoming Garden of Hope "is to create a positive space for families, friends, school-age children, nurses, first responders and all those affected by the loss of a child. A place where they can celebrate, honour, & remember the little one they miss. A garden that will bring life, hope, healing, comfort & a sense of community."

Council approved a sponsorship in the amount of \$5,000.00 to the Tiny Hands of Hope for the Blossoming Garden of Hope located in Grande Prairie, with funds to come from the Community Services Miscellaneous Grant Budget

### **July 12, 2022: Greenview to Support the County of Grande Prairie for Highway 40X Development**

The proposed Highway 40X expansion between Highway 43, west of Grande Prairie to Highway 40, south of Grande Prairie will be a key piece of road infrastructure allowing heavy truck traffic more efficient access to the industrial regions of Greenview, south of the Wapiti River. The County of Grande Prairie has requested a letter of support as they continue to work diligently to ensure this key infrastructure project advances

through Alberta Transportation and the Provincial government. Council moved to direct Administration to provide a letter of support for this development.

### **Greenview College, Trades, and Apprenticeship Scholarships Awarded for 2022**

The College, Trades, and Apprenticeship College Program and four (4) year University Program Scholarships provide an opportunity for students enrolled in secondary studies to apply for a scholarship. Council awarded six Trades and Apprenticeships Program Scholarships for a total of \$9,000 and ten University four (4) year College Scholarships for a total of \$25,000 with funds to come from the Community Services Budget. The Scholarship recipients list will be posted on the Greenview website.

### **July 12, 2022: Letter of Support Approved for Grande Spirit Foundation Seniors Needs Assessment**

The Grande Spirit Foundation Board of Directors has discussed local and regional needs assessments for affordable housing development of elder, community, and seniors housing. They have agreed that

working together as a collective and unified board is important to the success of the region and have requested that each municipality provide a letter of support that speaks with one voice to the Province for regional needs. Council moved to direct Administration to provide a letter of support to Grande Spirit Foundation for conducting a regional needs assessment survey.

#### **Aug. 26, 2022: Greenview to Proclaim September 19-25, 2022 as Rail Safety Week**

Administration received correspondence from Canadian National Railway (CN) requesting Council proclaim September 19-25, 2022, as Rail Safety Week in the Municipal District of Greenview to align with National Rail Safety Week across Canada. Council approved an official proclamation for the week of September 19- 25, 2022 as Rail Safety Week

#### **Sept. 14, 2022: 2022 Surplus Disposal**

Greenview Council approved the disbursement of surplus equipment and vehicles for the upcoming online Ritchie Brothers Auctioneers sale at their County of Grande Prairie location on October 5-7, 2022.

#### **Sept. 14, 2022: STARS Foundation – Letter of Support**

Council directed Administration to provide a letter of support to STARS Foundation regarding the Registered Emergency Site Questionnaire Project (RESQ). The RESQ Project plays an integral role and Greenview Council is supportive is the application of the Alberta Community Initiative Program grant for the RESQ Project.

## Building addition to the DeBolt Public Service Building

In 2020 Operations split the team in Grovedale to better cover the DeBolt area and started a group in DeBolt. Previously from Grovedale the team would respond to all maintained roads in this area including the Forestry Trunk Road. It was highly inefficient as each operator would spend over 2 ½ hours daily just getting to the area. When we calculated the annual cost “due to this inefficiency” the cost was over \$150,000 annually.

The team moved in 2020 but have been working without a shop since the move. Plans began to look for a location to build a standalone shop but ended with the decision to build on to the existing Public Service Building. The Engineering was completed to add a 28’ by 82’ bay by the Spring of this year and the

project tendered. Southwest Design and Construction were awarded the project and are currently in construction. The foundation work is well under way with an anticipated completion for the cement work by mid-September.

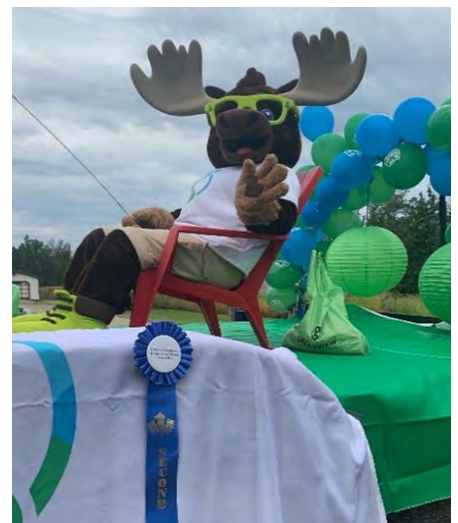
Due to supply shortages, delivery of the building structure is not scheduled until the middle of October and should take approximately 7 weeks to complete once the building steel arrives.

At the completion of this project, Operations will have a home-base in DeBolt which will significantly enhance their abilities to deliver a quality level of service to the area, especially in the winter months.

## GRANDE CACHE RECREATION CENTRE SAVING \$100,000 A YEAR WITH COMBINED HEAT & POWER (CHP)

Greenview has completed the installation of a new Combined Heat and Power (CHP) generating system for the Grande Cache Recreation Centre.

Manufactured by TEDOM, this natural gas generator can supply up to 144 KW of electrical power. Unlike a simple generator, any excess heat from its high-power engine is captured and routed to the Recreation Centre's main boiler.

Capturing and using this heat reduces the energy needed to keep the triple boilers running at a 60-degrees Celsius constant temperature.

With multiple swimming pools and a half dozen change rooms running hot showers over 12 hours a day, the Recreation Centre has high energy

needs for heating water. In this situation, a CHP makes particularly good economic sense.

In fact, the Grande Cache Recreation Centre's new CHP will save over \$106,000 a year on natural gas costs. Over its twenty-year lifetime, the CHP is expected to save 5,580 tonnes of greenhouse gas emissions.

The \$900,000 project was completed with a \$650,000 grant from the Municipal Climate Change Action Centre's Recreation Energy Conservation (REC) program. With the grant, the project should pay for itself in just two years.

The Municipal Climate Change Action Centre is a collaborative initiative between Alberta Municipalities, Rural Municipalities of Alberta, and the Government of Alberta. The Action Centre provides funding and technical assistance to municipalities, schools, and community organizations to lower energy costs and reduce greenhouse gas emissions.

The Tourism team partnered with our Outdoor Recreation and Communications Departments to create the "Passport to Fun" booklet this spring. This book highlights 22 different locations around Greenview and encourages individuals to explore the region in a fun and interactive way. Over 650 booklets were distributed this summer!

The Tourism Department is working alongside Travel Local and Travel Alberta to create a destination

development model that focuses on community well being while encouraging increased tourism. 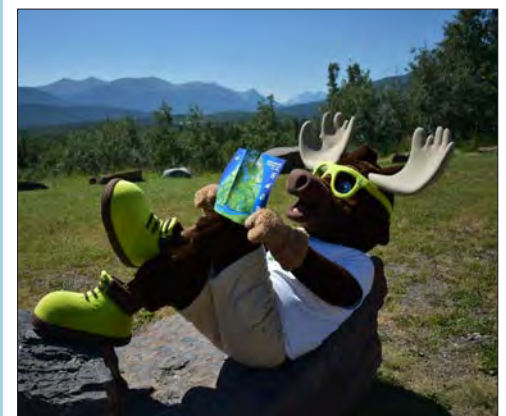

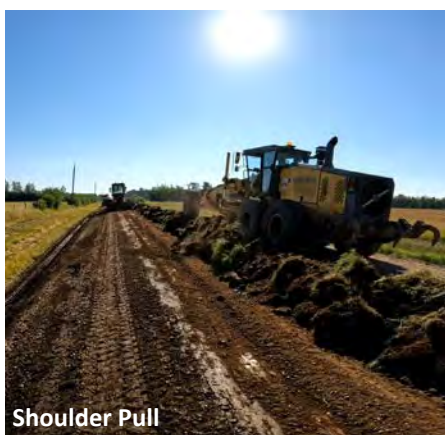

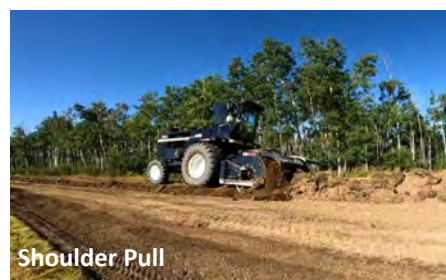

## Community Hall Assessments

As Greenview better understands Asset Management as a strategic process and the importance it plays on the longevity of Greenview's buildings, we start to look for better ways to effectively manage our assets. The Community Halls that spread throughout Greenview are one of the asset groups that we are reviewing to better understand the condition of for the Asset Management program.

To gain an understanding of the current condition of the halls, Facility Maintenance, working with Asset Management, are currently conducting Community Hall Conditions Assessments on the six Community Halls and two Arenas covered under Greenview's insurance. These assessments will provide an in-depth understanding of the buildings current state. This will be very useful for Administration and the Community Boards to determine a plan for the longevity of the buildings.

In order to conduct these assessments in a timely fashion, we are utilizing a team of assessors consisting of Electricians, Furnace Specialists, Carpenters, and Asset Management professionals. The team is focused on inspecting every inch of the buildings and surrounding grounds to look not only for items that will affect the assets longevity, but also any safety concerns.

We plan to complete this work before the end of September and have all the reports ready by the end of October. The reports will help with budgeting and provide the Community Boards a good understanding of their building's issues.

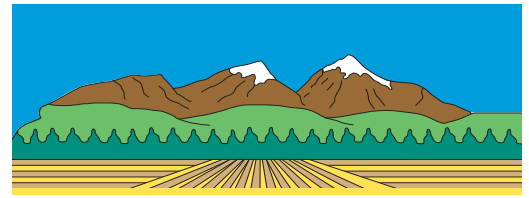
