- 1. SET your Recycle Cart curbside for pick-up every 2nd Monday by 7:00 am for Environmental 360 Solutions (E360S).
- **2. ENSURE** wheels are touching curb.
- **3. MUST HAVE** 6 feet of clearance on all sides of the car, such as parked cars, etc.
- 4. REVIEW acceptable materials included in curbside commingled recycling program on the back of the page.
- **5. CLEAN** recyclables & ensure they are dry.
- 6. ALL BLUE BAGS
 must be placed
 in the bin. Overflow
 items will not be
 accepted.

ABOUT:

Environmental 360 Solutions (E360S) was contracted in May 2022 for residential recycling pick-up in Grande Cache.

Your bin will continue to be picked up on the every second Monday. If a recycling day is scheduled on a statutory holiday, your bin will still be picked up. Remember to please leave your bin curbside by 7:00 am. See the reverse page for the 2023 Grande Cache Curbside Recycling Calendar. REMINDERS:

Please be reminded to only place the following acceptable recycling items in blue bags:

- **√** #1 & #2 plastics
- √ Tin cans
- ✓ Paper
- √ Cardboard
- **X** NO glass or organic materials
- √ No sorting required
- ✓ Ensure that items are clean & dry
- ✓ Blue bags must be in the recycling bin
- √ All items must be bagged
- **X** NO food stuck in containers



ALL items must be in BLUE BAGS & in the BLUE BIN.

ACCEPTABLE RECYCLING ITEMS



ACCEPTABLE: PLASTICS #1

Polyethylene terephthalate (PETE) is a clear or green, glossy, rigid container:

- **PETE** ✓ Clear and green soda bottles
 - √ Cooking oil bottles
 - √ Peanut butter jars (recyclable if clean)
 - √ Salad dressing bottles and other food and drink containers (recyclable if clean)



ACCEPTABLE: PLASTICS #2

High density polyethylene (HDPE) is also a hard plastic but is visibly different from PETE, as it is not transparent. It is usually milky or solid colors & rigid containers.

- ✓ Milk jugs and yogurt or margarine tubs (recyclable if clean)
- ✓ Detergent bottles, shampoo bottles, and other containers (recyclable if clean)
- √ Some plastic bags

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS INFO:



- √Tin/Steel Food Cans
 Labels are not required to be removed
- √All Beverage containers
- ✓ Plastics #1 & 2 Molded, rigid plastic containers & tubs with lids grade 1 & 2 only. All must be rinsed (i.e. detergent bottles, yogurt containers, condiment containers, plastic medicine bottles, etc.



- √ Office paper
- ✓ Newspaper
- ✓ Flyer's✓ Mailed paper
 - Envelopes, magazines, catalogues, corrugated cardboard, box-board (cereal boxes (no liners) &
