Welcome to the Summer Edition of Greenview’s Mountains to Meadows Quarterly Newsletter!

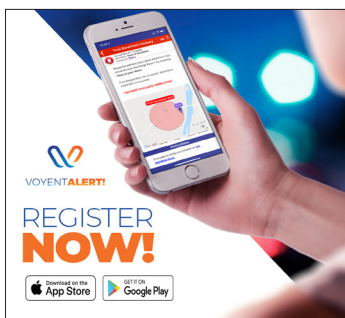

## Council Highlights Summary - Valleyview, Alberta

### April 9, 2024: Bear Creek Folk Music Festival Gets Greenview Support

The Bear Creek Folk Music Festival Society is hosting its 7th Annual Folk Music Festival on August 16-18, 2024, in Grande Prairie, Alberta. The festival is organized and run by a non-profit society and governed by a volunteer board that helps coordinate staff and over 500 volunteers each year to make this event successful. Council approved a sponsorship of \$5,500.00 to the Bear Creek Music Festival Society, with funds to come from the Community Services Sponsorship Budget.

### April 9, 2024: Letter of Support Approved for New K-12 School in Valleyview

The advancement of a new K-12 school underscores Greenview's shared commitment with the Town of Valleyview in investing in the future of the region and ensuring youth have access to the tools and resources they need to excel academically. Council directed Administration to provide a letter of support to the Northern Gateway School Division regarding the development of a new Kindergarten to Grade 12 School in a manner that has connectivity to the Greenview Regional Multiplex in Valleyview, AB. Council further directed Administration to arrange a meeting with representatives from the Northern Gateway School Division before the Council break in August 2024 to discuss the proposed interaction between the new school and the Greenview Regional Multiplex in more detail.

### May 14, 2024: Royal Canadian Legion #278 in Grande Cache Gets Greenview Support For a New Roof

The Royal Canadian Legion #278 (Grande Cache Legion) is a highly used community facility in the hamlet of Grande Cache. It has been used as a community hall to host various events for over 50 years. In January 2024, the roof at the Grande Cache Legion unexpectedly began leaking and has caused the Legion to close to the public several times due to safety concerns and it has been determined the building will require a new roof. Council approved a capital grant in the amount of \$100,000.00 to the Royal Canadian Legion #278 in Grande Cache for the new roof project, along with a reallocation of funds in the amount of \$36,747.56 from the 2023 capital grant for the new roof project or interior renovations as needed.

### May 28, 2024: Greenview Council Approves Livestock Veterinary Innovation Initiative Policy

The Livestock Veterinary Innovation Initiative aims to support innovative approaches to increase delivery options and geographic reach of veterinary care to livestock producers. Its goal is to enhance animal health and strengthen the livestock agri-food sector and food supply. This funding initiative seeks to address various challenges, such as the considerable distance between farmers and veterinary facilities and the shortage of large animal veterinarians in rural and remote areas of Greenview.

### May 28, 2024: Grant Request Supported by Greenview Council for Kakwa Sherman Trail Society

The Kakwa Sherman Trail Society is a newly formed not-for-profit organization that focuses on restoring and maintaining historical trails in the Sherman Meadows/Kakwa area. Through this work, the Society strives to protect the trail system's historical and cultural aspects while improving recreational opportunities. These trails are accessible to hikers, mountain bikers, and equestrian users. Greenview Council approved an operating grant of \$42,067.00 and a capital grant of \$14,028.00 to the Kakwa Sherman Trail Society to restore and maintain the historical trails in the Sherman Meadows and Kakwa Wildland areas. The funds will come from the 2024 Community Services Grants Budget.

### June 11, 2024: Greenview Council Approves Capital Grant for Little Smoky Cemetery Improvements

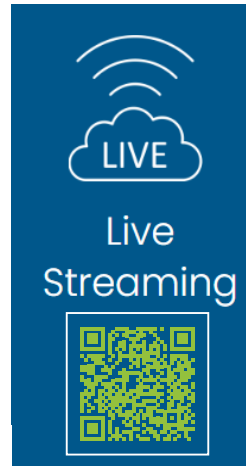
The Little Smoky Cemetery Committee was recently formed in August 2023, and the group applied within the regular grant process for new fencing to establish correct site boundaries. Council approved a capital grant of up to \$20,000.00 to the Little Smoky Cemetery Committee to purchase and install new chain-link fencing at the Cemetery.

### June 11, 2024: Nose Creek Area Fire Guard Grant Submission Supported

Administration has submitted an application to the FRIAA FireSmart Program to initiate Phase 1 planning for the potential construction of a fire guard to protect the settlement of Nose Creek. Estimated project costs are approximately \$40,000. A Council Resolution is required to allow the Forest Resource Improvement Association of Alberta (FRIAA) Grant Expression of Interest (EOI) to move forward for consideration and approval of a grant, and Council moved to support the submission.

### June 11, 2024: Aggregate Supply Tender Awarded

Council awarded Glacier Rock Resources Inc. the tender for the Aggregate Supply (4.25/1-inch) contract for New Fish Creek, Sunset House/Sweathouse, and Ridgevalley/Crooked Creek in the amount of \$960,000 plus GST, with funds coming from the Operations Gravel Purchasing budget. The Request for Tender was posted on the Alberta Purchasing Connection on April 12, 2024, with a submission deadline of May 7, 2024. Administration received three submissions for evaluation, with one proponent meeting all the mandatory requirements for consideration.

Signing up for local and provincial communications and downloading alerting apps can help keep community members informed so they are better able to respond to threats.

Greenview residents are encouraged to sign up for Voyent Alert to keep you informed of critical events like fires or floods

### Have a Plan

Preparedness is personal. Community members are encouraged to consider the unique needs of their households and the local threats when developing emergency plans.

Be Prepared tip: Every household is unique. Consider your household members' power requirements for medical devices, specific needs for children or pets, reliance on assistive technology, mobility issues and language barriers. Make your plan work for you.













### Build a Kit & Gather Supplies

Unexpected situations happen every day. Having supplies is one thing you can do to help your household better manage disruptions, whether they are big or small.

Imagine a long power outage in your area. Do you have enough food, water and provisions to keep you, your loved ones and your pets safe? Do you have the equipment to keep you connected and informed? What if you had to evacuate immediately? What would be important for you to bring? Personal documents? Medications? Extra clothing?

Having an emergency kit available is important to have prepared when you need to evacuate or to use it at home if you are required to have shelter in place.

Your kit should include contents to keep you safe, warm, and comfortable for at least 72 hours.

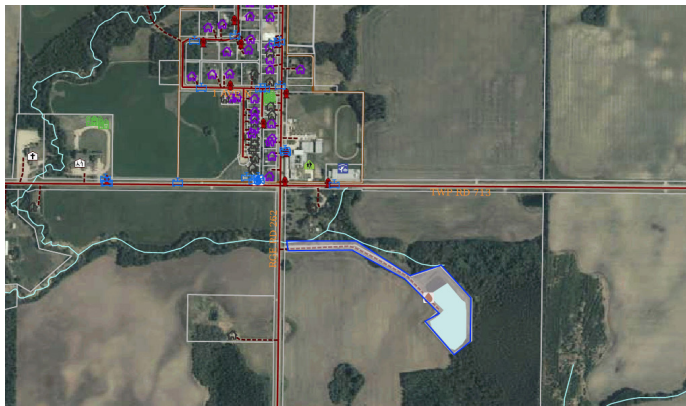
## Operations Updates

- Road maintenance work is ongoing in all areas of Greenview throughout the summer months. Please watch for crews repairing and installing culverts, line painting, pothole patching, mowing, grading, etc.
- Roadside ditch mowing began in June and will continue into mid-October.
- Roadside brushing began in May and will continue until the end of October.
- Greenview’s gravel program typically begins on the Forestry Trunk Road in May and in rural residential areas in July. Please watch for equipment and trucks working.
- Operations is going to be doing a trial with various products for dust control in 2024 in the Ridgevalley/Crooked Creek area and the Grovedale area.

# Environmental Services

## Utilities

### Ridgevalley Lagoon Expansion:



Greenview plans to expand the wastewater lagoon in Ridgevalley, which will enhance the community's waste management system, ensuring efficient and environmentally friendly treatment. This improvement supports future growth, attracts new businesses, and safeguards public health and the environment. Before the construction of the new lagoon cell begins, Greenview is desludging the existing cells this summer. Desludging a lagoon improves its efficiency and capacity for effective waste treatment, reducing the risk of overflow and environmental contamination. This process enhances water quality, ensuring a healthier environment for the community. Additionally, regular desludging extends the lifespan of the lagoon, contributing to long-term sustainability and cost savings.



### Grande Cache Waste Transfer Stations:

This year, planning is underway to construct a Waste Transfer Station in Grande Cache. Switching from a landfill to a waste transfer station reduces environmental impact by minimizing the need for large-scale landfills and promoting recycling and waste diversion. It also decreases local pollution and odours, enhancing community health and quality of life. Additionally, this transition can lead to more efficient waste management, reducing costs and improving overall service.

### Hydrant Flushing:

Hydrant Flushing will continue throughout Greenview over the summer months. Flushing hydrants is a proactive and preventive measure that contributes to a water distribution system's overall health and functionality. It plays a crucial role in maintaining water quality, preventing bacterial growth, ensuring fire protection capabilities, and identifying and addressing potential issues within the system. Regular flushing is often part of a water utility's routine maintenance program.

### Grande Cache Water and Sanitary Main Extension May 21 - July 31, 2024:

Greenview is currently extending and upgrading the water and sewer lines along 98 Street and 104 Avenue in Grande Cache. Upgrading and extending the water and sanitary lines enhances public health by providing reliable access to clean water and efficient waste disposal. It promotes economic growth by attracting new businesses and residents and increasing property values. Additionally, the improved infrastructure supports sustainable development and enhances the overall quality of life in the community.





## Solid Waste

### Alberta Recycling Management Authority:

In the spring of 2025, Circular Materials, under the regulatory body of the Alberta Recycle Management Authority (ARMA) will assume responsibility for all residential recycling across Alberta, including Greenview, as part of the Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) program. This initiative will shift recycling costs to the producers of single-use products, packaging and printed paper products (PPP), eliminating the need for to cover these expenses. As a result, Greenview will benefit from more efficient recycling services at no additional cost.

### Wood at Transfer Sites during Fire Bans:

This summer, wood disposal at transfer sites may be subject to site-specific restrictions based on local fire bans. Please regularly check the Greenview website and notices at transfer sites for updates on wood piles filling up, during fire ban conditions. If fire bans are not in effect, these restrictions will not apply. Site-specific wood restrictions will only be enforced during extended fire bans.

### Sewage Treatment Plant Road & Trail Closures, Grande Cache:

Effective April 1 to November 30, 2024, the **Sewage Treatment Plant Road is closed, along with the trails leading off or onto the road** due to the construction of the new Wastewater Treatment Plant, affecting trail access in the area. **This is an active construction site, so please respect road closure signs.**

**The following trails are included in the closures, so please plan your trail route accordingly:**


- No access to the Sewage Treatment Plant Road.
- Trails leading off or onto the Sewage Treatment Plant Road will be inaccessible, and the road will be fenced, so there will be no access.
- No access to Bucksaw Ridge Trail (Trail 29) from the Sewage Treatment Plant Road.
- No access to Bucksaw Ridge Trail (Trail 29) from The View Trail (Trail 40).
- No access to The Great Escape Trail (Trail 9) from the Sewage Treatment Plant Road.
- No access to The Great Escape Trail (Trail 9) from The View Trail (Trail 40), Rabbits Trail (Trail 15) or Sulphur Slide (Trail 38).
- No access from Peaks to Creek (Trail 2) off Riverview Trail (Trail 16) to or from the Sewage Treatment Plant Road.

### Additional Development:

A new Pressure Reducing Valve (PRV) Station will be constructed on the gravel parking lot at the bottom of the jail hill road.

### Advocating for Greenview's Agricultural Producers

Greenview Council and ASB Members had the opportunity to attend a crucial meeting with Minister of Agriculture and Irrigation RJ Sigurdson, MLA Nolan Dyck, and MLA Ron Wiebe advocating for Greenview's Agricultural Producers.

During our discussions, we emphasized the unique challenges faced by our local farmers and ranchers. Unlike other regions, our municipalities primarily comprise extensive forested crown lands, with smaller areas of privately held agricultural lands. This unique landscape often leads to the Canadian Drought Monitor's data missing the nuanced differences in precipitation patterns here, which impacts the accuracy of the information that drives crucial decisions.

Moreover, we raised concerns about the increase in predatory issues for farmers and ranchers, which adds another layer of difficulty to their already demanding work.

Greenview's agricultural community is at the heart of a dynamic and challenging environment. The Agricultural Service Board (ASB) is tirelessly working to understand and tackle these complexities, reflecting a deep commitment to our region. Let's continue to support and stand by our farmers and ranchers, ensuring their invaluable contributions are recognized and protected.

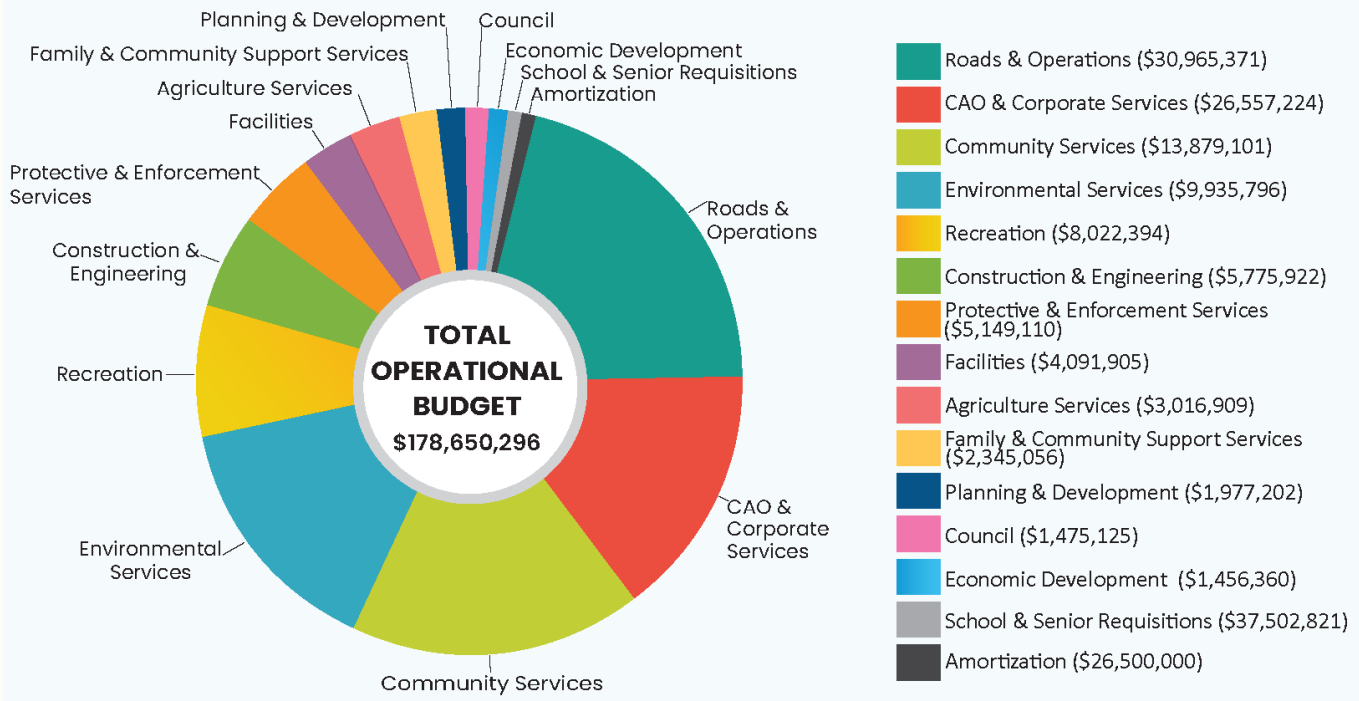




# MD OF GREENVIEW 2024 BUDGET AT A GLANCE

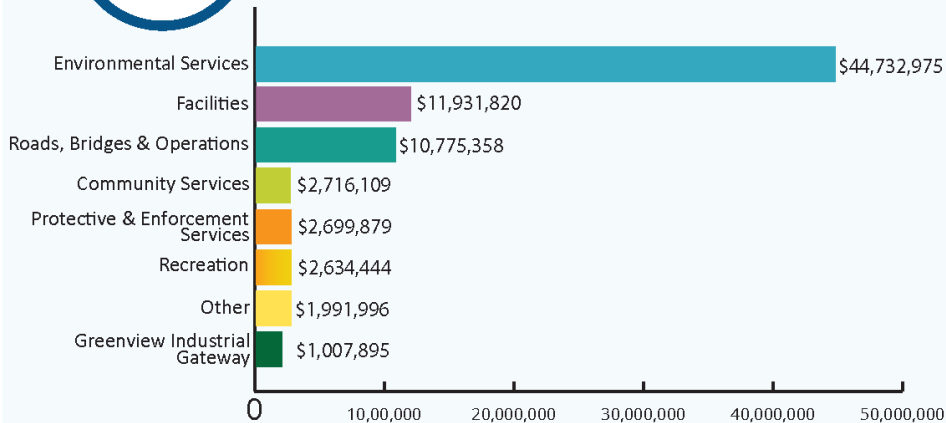

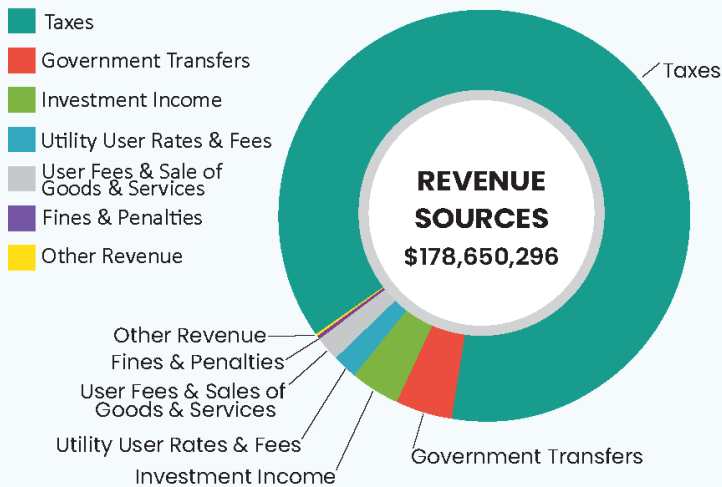

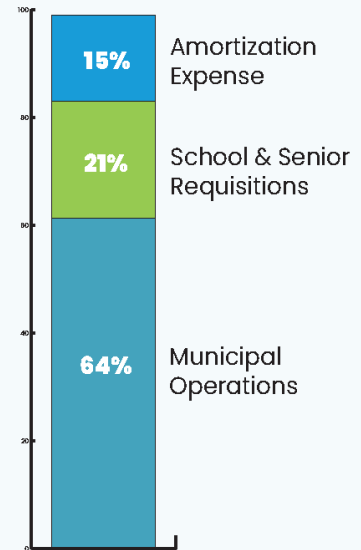
## KEY CAPITAL BUDGET HIGHLIGHTS

## Agricultural Services - Greenviews Weed Control Program

Greenview has multiple programs available to residents and ratepayers to access to control invasive species. Here is a list and brief description of each program:

### Weed Free Forage Program Assistance Program

Becoming a Certified Weed-Free Forage Producer is simple, it starts with a conversation with your Municipal Agricultural Services Office. Any forage stand can be declared weed-free, even if it's not the entire field, allowing the producer to market their weed-free product to interested purchasers.

### Rural Acreage Owner Program

The Rural Acreage Owner Program was initiated to ensure rural acreage owners (RAO) have access to select Commercial class herbicides to control Prohibited Noxious and Noxious weeds (as identified in the Weed Control Act). If you're a Greenview resident, call us to see if you qualify!

### Weed Incentive Program

Greenview offers a Weed Incentive Program of up to \$15/acre to a maximum of 160 acres to control select regulated weed species. This incentive program is for Pastures, hay lands, grazing leases, and grazing reserves. Funding for this program is on a first come first served basis. ### Herbicide Retailer

Greenview Agricultural Services has been designated as a herbicide retailer for a select few range and pasture products. This program is available for landholders who have pasture, hay land, grazing leases, and/or a grazing reserve and wish to control weed species on their property.

## Business Licenses are now required in Greenview Hamlets

### Greenview Business License Information:

Business Licenses are required for businesses located within Greenview Hamlets. Any person who owns or operates a business within Greenview may obtain a business license in accordance with Bylaw 23-951 and receive the benefits provided by Greenview for business support initiatives. This applies to all types of businesses as stated in our Land Use Bylaws 18-800 & 799, available at <https://mdgreenview.ab.ca/government/policies-bylaws/>

A business license shows the public that your business meets requirements and is permitted to operate within Greenview. A license may be required for insurance purposes or licensing requirements applicable to organizations outside of Greenview. Greenview is able to offer several Small Business Tax Incentives, if your business is eligible, and provide assistance on other government funding and programs that may be available to business owners.

### Storefront Stream Beautification Grant

Businesses that are eligible for Storefront Stream can apply for up to 70% of total project costs up to a maximum of \$5,000.00.

To be eligible for the Storefront Stream, applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Operate a small business on a parcel of land zoned for commercial purposes as per Greenview's Land Use Bylaw.

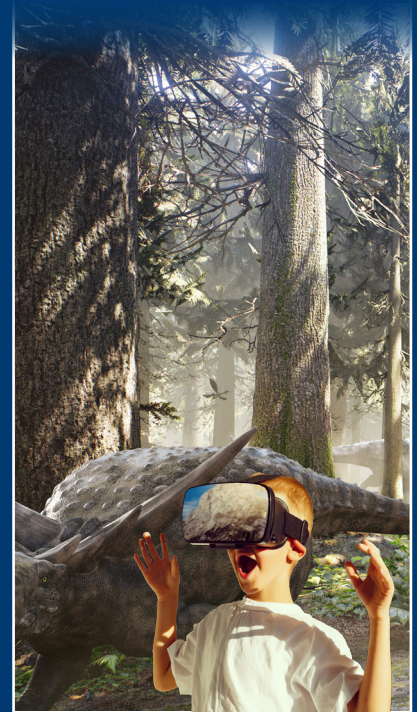

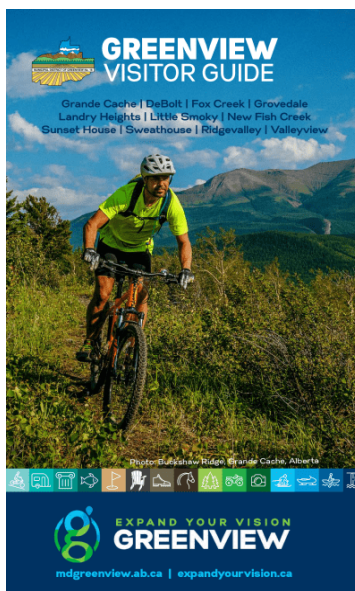

## Grande Cache Recreation Centre Arena Pad update and photos

The Grande Cache Recreation Centre Arena, constructed in 1970 with several additions over the decades, has been a vital part of the community, hosting minor and senior hockey, figure skating, public activities, and numerous events. However, the aging ice pad has developed significant issues, such as large cracks, tripping hazards, frost heaves, and persistent cooling (brine) leaks. Despite these challenges, the arena remains well-regarded in the hockey community for its excellent ice surface quality.

The arena's wooden dasher boards are also outdated and compromised, susceptible to moisture and

damage. Replacing the arena pad necessitates the removal and replacement of these boards as well.

In September 2023, a geotechnical investigation was conducted to assess the arena's sub-slab and soil conditions, revealing poor but acceptable conditions for its construction era and no insulation.

On March 26, 2024, Greenview Council approved a capital project to replace the arena ice pad and dasher boards, awarding the project to Bry Sand Ice Arena Ltd of Edmonton, Alberta. Deconstruction began on April 8, 2024, and the project is on schedule, with completion expected by August 30, 2024. Ice installation is planned for early September, as in previous years.

The Grande Cache Arena Pad installation continues to progress on track and on time as scheduled. Below are photo's indicating first level heating line installation, floor after heating lines are buried and then next process of insulation and vapor barrier under-way before next phase of cooling line installation. (as of May 29, 2024 )

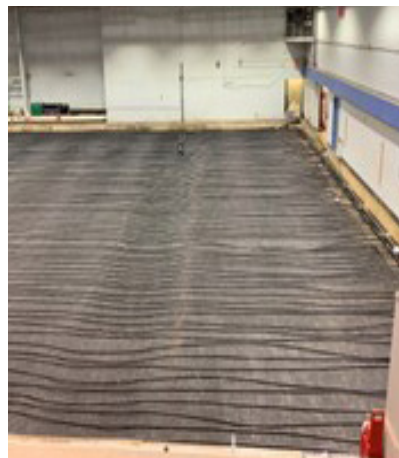
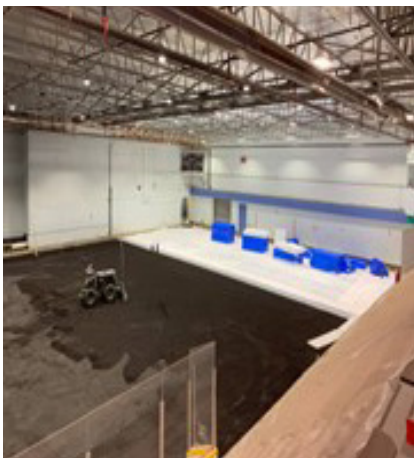
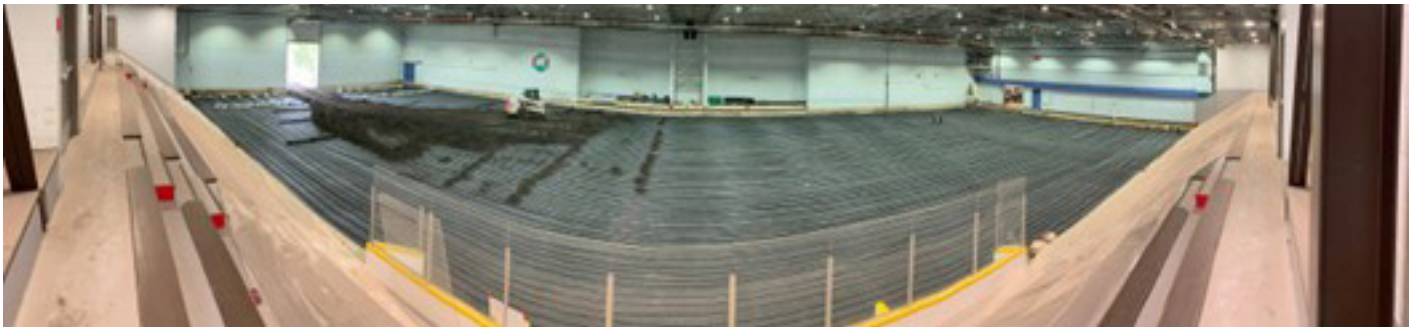

## Sign up for the Tax Installment Payment Plan (TIPP)

If interested in the TIPP but missed the January deadline, you can now enroll during any month by submitting the application form before the 20<sup>th</sup> of any month. Scan QR code below for Application.

The Tax Installment Payment Plan (TIPP) offers MD of Greenview taxpayers a convenient plan that enables you to pay your property tax in 12 monthly payments (January-December) instead of one annual payment.

Your payment automatically comes out of your account on the last business day of every month, making budgeting easier and eliminating late penalties. Payment due dates are indicated on your property tax bill.

Monthly payments are calculated by dividing the annual tax levy from the preceding year by twelve (12) for the payment amount for January to May. The monthly payments from June to December will be the amount owing after the new levy is calculated divided by seven (7) months. This will result in a zero balance at the end of the year. You will be notified of the change in payment amount on your tax notice. TIPP automatically continues

from year to year; you only need to enroll once.

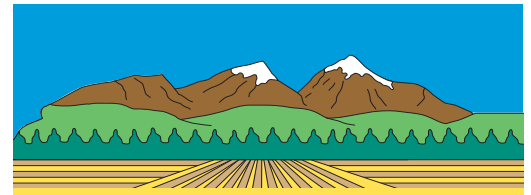
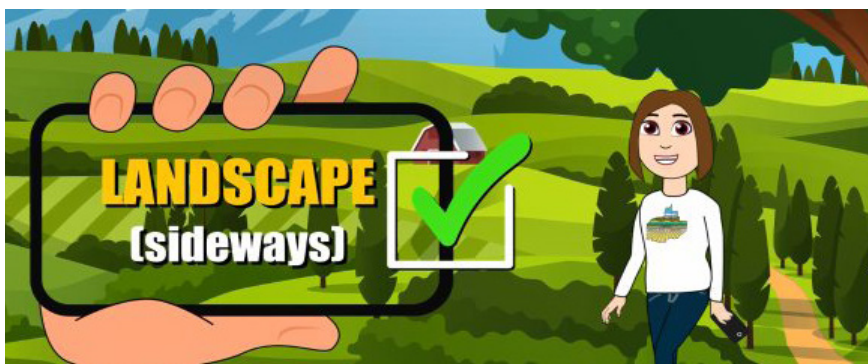
