ABOUT THE TRANSFER STATION:

Exciting news, Grande Cache! Our new Transfer Station opens March 10, 2026, introducing a cleaner and safer way to manage waste. Landfill waste will now be diverted into the transfer bins. Please follow on-site signage and our staff will assist with sorting and answer any questions.

Same location: 1.2 km north of Grande Cache off Highway 40

TRANSFER STATION HOURS:

- Tuesday - Saturday: 10:30 am - 6:00 pm
- Last vehicle into the facility is at 5:30 pm
- Closed Sunday, Monday & Statutory Holidays and closed Saturdays of long weekends

WASTE SEPARATION:

To keep the site safe, clean, and efficient, all waste must be separated into proper categories.

Transfer Bins - What Is Allowed:

Household waste only. This includes:

- Bagged kitchen and bathroom waste
- Regular weekly household refuse

Not Allowed In Transfer Bins (Prohibited):

- Metal
- Wood
- Large items (like tree stumps)
- Heavy items (like shingles)
- Batteries
- Electronics
- Construction or renovation materials
- Furniture
- Appliances
- Hazardous waste

Where to Put Other Materials:

Separate onsite construction bins will be provided for:

- Construction & demolition waste
- Bulky items such as yard waste, tree stumps, shingles, etc.

Separate areas for:

- Wood
- Metal (appliances)
- Batteries
- E-waste (TV, computer, microwave etc.)
- Tires
- Grass clippings & yard waste
- Propane tanks (max. size 30 lbs)

Improper use may result in:

- Fines
- Refusal to unload
- Additional charges

Plan Your Trip:

- Secure your load to prevent litter and hazards.
- Sort your load before you arrive.
- Follow onsite signage and staff directions.
- All small engine motors must be drained of all fluid and oils. For example, vehicles, weed wackers, chainsaws, lawnmowers, dirt bikes, ATVs, etc.

On-site staff will be available to assist, guide, and answer questions during the transition period.

BOTTLE BINGE DEPOT PROGRAM INFORMATION:

Residents are encouraged to donate recyclable bottles/cans at the Bottle Binge Depot, located at the entrance of the Grande Cache Transfer Station. Greenview will then donate the collected bottles to a local, non-profit organization from Grande Cache.

BOTTLE BINGE DEPOT HOURS:

- Tuesday - Saturday 10:30 am - 6:00 pm (last entry at 5:30 pm)

HOW TO APPLY:

Non-profit organizations are invited to apply to collect the donated bottles from the Bottle Binge Depot.

- To request an application form, please call 1-825-347-2108
- Please email completed forms to GCenviroadmin@mdgreenview.ab.ca
- Eligible non-profit organizations will be contacted when bottles are available for pickup at the Grande Cache Transfer Station
- Once notified, the selected organization must collect the recyclable bottles within five (5) days of the contact date. If the bottles are not collected within this timeframe, the organization will forfeit their opportunity to collect them at that time

GRANDE CACHE RESIDENTIAL CURBSIDE RECYCLING COLLECTION:

- Pick up every second Monday

Please ensure:

- Place blue recycle cart curbside by 7:00 am
- Materials must be clean, dry and bagged in your recycling cart
- Flatten all cardboard
- Give containers a quick rinse
