**DATE:** April 17, 2026

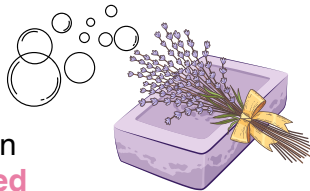
**TIME:** 3:15-5:15
