



BYLAW 26-1021

of the Municipal District of Greenview No. 16

A Bylaw of the Municipal District of Greenview No. 16, in the Province of Alberta to Amend Sections and Schedule A within Bylaw 25-991.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A., 2000, c.M-26 and amendments thereto, the Council of a municipality may pass bylaws for the safety, health and welfare of people and the protection of people and property;

AND WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 191 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A., 2000, c.M-26 and amendments thereto, a Council has the power to amend enacted bylaws;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipal District of Greenview No. 16, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. TITLE

1.1. This Bylaw may be cited as “Animal Control Amendment”.

2. DEFINITIONS

2.1. **Greenview** means the Municipal District of Greenview No. 16.

3. AMENDMENTS

3.1. Bylaw 25-991 Animal Control, is amended by changing the Schedule A list numbers to align with the corresponding section in Bylaw 25-991 and will be amended as follows:

- a) 4.9 becomes 4.8,
- b) 4.11 becomes 4.9,
- c) 5.5 becomes 5.4,
- d) 5.6 becomes 5.5,
- e) 5.8 becomes 5.7,
- f) 9.6 becomes 9.5; and
- g) 9.10 becomes 6.1 (E)

3.2. Bylaw 25-991, Animal Control, is amended by moving section 4.8 within Schedule A, titled “Failure to confine an animal in heat” to 4.13.

3.3. Bylaw 25-991, Animal Control, is amended by adding section 4.13 to section 4 and Schedule A as section 4.13 and will read as follows:

“4.13. An Owner of an animal shall ensure that the animal is not at large while in heat and is confined to the Owner’s property.”

3.4. Bylaw 25-991, Animal Control, is amended to include the addition of “or animal” in Schedule (A) 4.8.



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- 3.5. Bylaw 25-991, section 4.8 is repealed and replaced with the following: “An Owner shall ensure that their Animal does not bite, chase, or Attack any Person, or Animal whether on public or private property or in a private dwelling, except where the Animal is reasonably acting in defense of its Owner, Livestock, property, or dwelling.”
- 3.6. By law 25-991, section 4.10.i. is repealed and replaced with the following: 4.10 C) “Not more than twenty-five (25) Working Dogs, older than six (6) months, per household, outside of a Hamlet Service Area.”
- 3.7. Bylaw 25-991, Animal Control, is amended to add “cause of death” in section 5.1 and will read as follows:
“The Owner of a Dangerous Dog shall take all necessary steps to ensure that the Dangerous Dog does not bite, chase, Attack or cause the death of any Person, whether on public or private property or in a dwelling.”
- 3.8. Bylaw 25-991, Animal Control, is amended to add “cause of death” in section 5.2 and will read as follows:
“The Owner of a Dangerous Dog shall take all necessary steps to ensure that the Dangerous Dog does not bite, chase, Attack or cause the death of any Animal or Livestock, whether on public or private property or in a dwelling.”
- 3.9. Bylaw 25-991, Animal Control, is amended by the removal of section 5.4 within Schedule A titled, “Failure to properly confine a Dangerous Dog on the Owner’s property.”
- 3.10. Bylaw 25-991, Animal Control, is amended by changing the description of 6.1(E) in Schedule A, to read as follows:
“Failure to follow a direction or order given by a Peace Officer.”
- 3.11. Bylaw 25-991, Animal Control, is amended by removing “Cats” from Schedule A section 4.10.
- 3.12. Bylaw 25-991, Animal Control, is amended by repealing and replacing section 4.11, within Schedule A, to read as follows:
“Exceeding the quantity of Cats within a Hamlet Service Area.”
- 3.13. Bylaw 25-991, Animal Control, is amended by adding section 8.1 to Schedule A, to read as follows:
“Animal Running at Large, First Offence \$100.00, Second Offence \$250.00, Third and Subsequent Offences, \$500.00.”



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3.14. Bylaw 25-991, Animal Control, is amended by the addition to section 9.1 of “with a minimum fine of \$50 not exceeding a maximum fine of \$10,000 or” and will read as follows:

“Any Person who contravenes a provision of this Bylaw is guilty of an offence and may be issued a violation ticket with a minimum fine of \$50 not exceeding \$10,000 or as outlined in Schedule A.”

4. COMING INTO FORCE

4.1. This Bylaw shall come into force and effect upon the day of third and final reading.

Read a first time this 12 day of May 2026.

Read a second time this 9 day of June 2026.

Read a third time this 9 day of June 2026.
