


















During the summer months, we will spend most of our time together outdoors exploring the beautiful Birds Eye View Park. From bubbles and bugs to outdoor story-time and nature adventures, each session is designed to spark curiosity, imagination, and connection for both children and caregivers alike!

This program is designed to be a leisurely, fun, interpretive hiking experience, offering a chance to discover stunning landscapes right here in our own little hamlet while learning along the way. Whether you're brand new to hiking or already love the trails, this is a welcoming opportunity to get outside, build confidence, and enjoy the mountains in good company. We're ready to conquer our second peak of the summer! Join us as we tackle the beautiful Ambler Mountain. Open to ages 18+ and all experience levels.

**Trailhead:** Located 9km north on Hwy. 40, then turn left onto Beaverdam Road. After driving 6.5 km, you will reach a low pass and begin to descend. As soon as the road begins to descend, watch for a signed area with trails on either side of the roadway. To the left, you will find the 'Amber Loop' trail. If you would prefer to meet at the Tourism Centre and follow staff please let us know upon registration.
