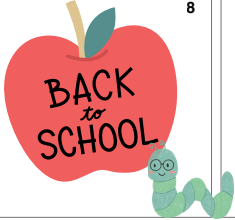
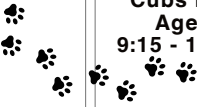

Little Cache Cubs Drop-In

DATE: September 17, 24

TIME: 9:15 - 11:15 am

AGES: 0-5 years

COST: FREE with a non-perishable food item donation

Parented program (meaning parents are to attend the program with their child or children)

NO registration required.

DESCRIPTION: Enjoy some social time with other parents and caregivers while the Interpretive Programmer keeps your little ones engaged in discovering the wonders of Grande Cache history, wildlife, and nature through age-appropriate sensory play, stories, crafts, and hands-on activities. From bubbles and bugs to outdoor story time and nature adventures, each session is designed to spark curiosity, imagination, and connection for children and caregivers alike!

Non-Parented Program (meaning parents drop off and do not need to stay)

Registration Required

DESCRIPTION: Celebrate the beauty of fall with our 1.5-hour outdoor after-school program! Each week, we'll explore the trails near the Tourism Centre while learning about the changing seasons.

Topics will include Grande Cache history, local wildlife and their tracks and scat, seasonal changes in animal behaviour, and how nature and habitats adapt as summer turns to fall.
